Footnotes

DUBAI MAGPIE broke readily to gain terms with the several rivals on the pace along the rail racing into the first turn, drifted a bit racing through that bend while crossing into the path of LUCIA BUNS and SILVER SUNRISE, was righted to dispute the pace inside a rival through the backstretch, shook clear leaving the midway point of the far turn and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. DECISIVE ACTION joined the pace four deep soon after the break, shifted inwards entering the backstretch while forcing the issue outside a rival, pressed that foe into the far turn, couldn't match terms nearing upper stretch but continued with interest to save place honors. VOL DU VENT settled along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out on the far turn to split foes racing into upper stretch and gained some position while altering her course several times in the final furlong. GOTTA DANCE delayed proceedings when refusing to load in the gate, broke awkwardly, shifted to the rail while steadily gaining contention racing into the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch and lacked the needed final response. LUCIA BUNS, close up between foes in the opening stages, lost some position racing in tight quarters midway through the first turn, continued between foes into the second bend and steadily faded racing into the stretch. EMILY OSTROSKI settled in last while working her way to the inside, saved ground throughout but never seriously menaced. SILVER SUNRISE, urged to contend three deep between foes racing to the first turn, was steadied out of close quarters leaving the seven furlong marker, continued outside foes to the far turn, drifted five wide into the stretch and steadily faded.
