MILTOS EXPRESS set the pace from the inside on a clear lead but could not last. CHRISTINAS COURAGE raced close up off the rail and made a bid in the stretch but faltered. LEAPING LILY lacked speed and improved her position. SHE IS WHAT SHE IS raced close up off the rail and gave way. ETOILE PETITE also gave way. VOODOO FEVER tired in the drive. RAVENNA was outrun.
