TEMPLAR'S CUP was void of early speed, split horses in the turn then angled in and got up in time. RIVERSIDE RASCAL set a fast pace, was pressed the entire way and just held place. CATMANTOO showed no speed, was asked while six wide and closed willingly. SAM BLACK CHURCH had a rail trip, angled out and made a mild rally but was outfinished. DEVIL IN EXCESS settled early, was asked between horses but made no rally. BEAUFORT raced in the second flight then dropped back and was no threat. AUTOBEACAT was allowed to settle but had no late response. WINCHESTER BAY stumbled badly at the start and rushed up, pressed the pace and stopped.
