**Footnotes**

DANDYMAN was settled off the second flight in the opening stages, was roused to split foes three deep entering upper stretch, angled out five wide racing nearing midstretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. DE GREEN LIGHT was hustled to dispute the pace along the inside from the break, shook clear racing into upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. TWINE, forwardly placed five wide in the opening stages, advanced to challenge three wide racing through the turn but had no final kick while lasting for a share. LAKOTA WOLF broke inwards bumping JOE MATT, was collected off that foe to track off the second flight, angled four wide racing into the stretch and continued evenly to late stages. NATHAN CHICAGO, prominent four wide between foes in the opening stages, pressed a rival on the turn to upper stretch and gave way. PISTOL PERSUASION, reluctant to load, hopped at the start, was settled out of close quarters just after the break, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. CHAS THE MAN tracked the pace between foes from out of striking distance early and never gained contention. WHISPERING BREEZE chased the leaders along the inside racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. JOE MATT, bumped at the start, never gained contention. AUGUST DAY flashed brief pace between foes but retreated from contention early. EL TRUENOS settled off the second flight in early stages and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. BRIM soon trailed.
