STAKES Indian Maid S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Nominations close Wednesday, September 28, 2011 with no fee. A supplementary nomination may be made at time of entry for \$1,500 which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$1,000 to pass the entry box; original nominees that start will receive a \$750 rebate. \$60,000 added, of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three year olds, 120 lbs., Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs.; non-winners of \$18,600 twice at a mile or over in 2011, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered.) High weights (including scale of weights) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights and second parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. In the event of an over-subscribed field, lowweighted horses preference will be determined by highest career earnings. Nominations closed Wednesday, September 28, 2011 with 34. (Rail at 10 feet).

HAPPY HENRIETTA moved to the fore along the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a clear margin while on her own courage racing to the far turn, was roused to extend her advantage entering upper stretch and held MOURETTE safe under steady handling. The latter worked her way to the inside early tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to close the gap. INSTANT STYLE angled to the rail stalking the leaders along the inside under reserve in the opening half, shifted out in upper stretch while being roused to challenge and continued willingly between foes to prevail for a share. TRAC N JAM, allowed to settle near the inside in the opening half, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. AFLEET DECEIT, held up outside a rival tracking off the second flight racing

to the far turn, angled out five wide racing through the stretch while making a mild bid. BORN INDY U S A, allowed to settle along the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve her position between foes along the inside. LA ROCCA tracked just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, lodged a brief bid between foes racing through the far turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. JALAL, held up outside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, lacked a closing response. ABUELA, caught four wide racing into the first turn while pulling her way along to a forward placing, continued in that path racing into the far turn while making a brief bid but quickly gave way in upper stretch. W W AMERICAN, reserved between foes in the opening stages, never mounted a serious challenge. SENIGA, reserved from out of striking distance along the rail in the opening stages, made some brief progress inside foes after a half, was steadied a bit when appearing to take an awkward step approaching the far turn and quickly retreated from contention. SANTINA DOND, urged to secure striking distance racing three deep between foes racing to the first turn, continued in that path for five furlongs and steadily retreated racing through the far turn.
