STAKES Hawthorne Gold Cup H. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which shall accompany the nomination. A supplementary nomination of \$10,000 may be made on Saturday, October 1, 2011, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$2,500 to pass the entry box and \$2,500 additional to start, with \$500,000 guaranteed; the purse will be divided 60 percent to the winning owner, 20 percent to second, 10 percent to third, 5 percent to fourth, 3 percent to fifth and 2 percent divided equally among the remaining finishers. A trophy will be awarded to the winning owner. WEIGHTS, SUNDAY, OCTOBER 2, 2011. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to fourteen starters. High weights (including scale of weights and sex allowance) will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights, and second weighted parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. Failure to draw into race will cancel all fees, with the exception of nomination fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Footnotes

HEADACHE, reserved from just out of striking distance while angling nearer the inside in the opening stages, continued between foes under patient handling while shifting out racing into the backstretch, was urged to advance four wide between foes racing through the far turn and continued with a steady late response to narrowly edge WHERE'S STERLING in the final stages under strong handling in a prolonged drive. The latter, held up outside foes from just out of striking distance racing three deep to the backstretch, commenced his advance entering the far turn while shifting out four wide, struck the front nearing upper stretch, continued in an extended skirmish for command past midstretch, resisted the winner's bid to the end and just failed to contain that foe while just prevailing for place honors. CEASE broke outwards, was righted to gain a position four wide racing to the first turn outside foes in the second flight while exchanging some contact with MOE MAN, attended the pace in that path on the backstretch, moved to press the issue three deep entering the far turn, shifted to the inside nearing upper stretch while continuing to dispute the issue past midstretch and continued grudgingly to the end. MISTER MARTI GRAS was settled just off the inside racing to the backstretch, angled outside foes racing through the far turn, swung six wide in upper stretch and made some belated progress. GIANT OAK, firmly reserved outside foes while caught four wide racing into the backstretch, loomed outside the leaders five wide leaving the far turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. MARISTAR broke awkwardly, was settled into stride near the inside, shifted out four wide on the far

turn while being roused to contention, raced in that path into upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. RULE tracked just off the pacesetter under light rating racing inside foes as part of the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued between foes nearing the far turn but soon came up empty. MOE MAN was urged to position between foes in the second flight in the opening stages while exchanging some contact with CEASE nearing the first turn, advanced on the pacesetter entering the backstretch to briefly press the pace between foes racing into the far turn but quickly emptied out nearing upper stretch. WORLDLY, unhurried tracking the leaders along the inside from just out of striking distance, shifted out to race three wide between foes entering the far turn but gave way nearing upper stretch. CHEROKEE LORD moved to the fore soon after the break, shifted to the inside after the opening furlong, set the pace on a narrow margin along the inside racing to the far turn and gave way abruptly on the second bend.
