The latter settled in while not far back, challenged outside the winner in the stretch and just missed. BEBOPPIN BABY lacked speed, rallied in the stretch and gained a share in a good effort. APALACHEE SPECIAL lacked speed then improved his position in the drive. DA DEVIL also improved his position. FACT NOT FICTION pressed the pace and tired. FORT METFIELD checked in tight quarters throughout the entire stretch the first time then tired after a half. BRITE ADAM raced in good position but tired.
