Footnotes

TOAST IN THE PARK secured a forward placing outside foes racing into the first turn, tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight to the far turn, made a steady advance to striking distance shifting out three wide entering upper stretch, wrestled command leaving the furlong marker and just contained TEXAS HEDGE in an all out drive. The latter tracked the pace between foes in the flight in the opening half, angled out four wide leaving the far turn while moving to challenge, drew on terms with the winner in late stages and was just outnodded. MOMENTARILY sped to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into upper stretch but yielded to the top pair late. LUCKY MERLOT tracked just off and outside the second flight racing to the far turn, angled out four wide entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. FRANK'S TIME stumbled at the start, tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance and continued evenly to late stages. STAR VECTOR tracked just off the pacesetter into the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes on the far turn but gave way nearing midstretch. DADDY FORTY NINE settled outside foes from out of striking distance early and never gained contention. SWORD AND SHIELD steadily faded after a half. TEJANO TAYLOR never seriously menaced. COUNTRY TOWN tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight racing into the backstretch, then steadily retreated racing through the far turn. IRISH RUFFIAN soon trailed.
