SUMMER'S EMPIRE, reserved between foes from out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing the far turn commencing a steady, four wide advance continued in that path to challenge for command nearing midstretch and just prevailed in a long drive. SERENGETI TOUR stalked the pacesetter under rating inside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, moved to challenge between foes nearing upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge to the end and was just outfinished. CORNEL NOBLE, caught five wide racing through the first turn while being prompted to secure a contending position, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight racing to the second bend, bid for command three deep between foes racing into upper stretch and was just outfinished. CHIEF BEAR tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the far turn, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued to make a mild gain. YONA TORY settled near the inside in the opening stages, swung out racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress. PESCADERO, held up four wide between foes while caught in close quarters racing into the first turn, continued outside a rival tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn but couldn't produce a closing bid. CUBAN MISSILE pulled his way to the lead along the inside, set the pace on a clear margin racing into the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch. A P DREAMER, reserved along the inside tracking just off the second flight, dropped back on the backstretch, raced six wide through the far turn and never seriously menaced.
