Footnotes

MARQUET DANCER broke outwards bumping OH SO LO at the start, was quickly righted to track the leaders leading the second flight four wide racing to the bend, continued in that path into upper stretch while gradually drawing into striking distance, then found his best stride late to just prevail on the wire under pressure. KING OF CANDYLAND broke sharply, attended a rival's pace under light rating racing to the bend, moved clear entering upper stretch and just failed to contain the winner. CLANDESTINE FURY, forwardly placed between foes stalking the pace, bid between foes nearing upper stretch and continued willingly to late stages to prevail for a share. RAINBOW CLUB tracked the leaders five wide in the second flight racing to the turn, continued in that path into upper stretch and was making steady progress late. RAP ON FELIX, allowed to settle in the opening stages, swung out entering upper stretch and made some belated progress four deep between foes. OH SO LO, bumped at the start, was righted to track the pace four wide between foes just off the second flight racing to the turn but lacked the needed rally. COVERT MISSION tracked the pace between foes in the second flight in the opening stages but offered no rally. RAIL BENDER, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the turn, gave way after a half. A P GOLDENBOY was never a factor.
