Footnotes

WINNING WILDCAT tracked off the second flight under reserve while shifting off the inside racing through the backstretch, angled five wide entering upper stretch while being roused to advance and produced a steady late rally to just edge GOLD DE LAC in time under firm handling. The latter broke inwards bumping a rival, gained a position behind the second flight near the inside racing to the turn, moved to split foes entering upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage between calls late despite the loss of his rider's whip and just missed. SPICY JACK tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight racing to the bend, took over entering upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. C SAGA RYDER bumped at the start, settled off the inside racing to the bend, steadied in close quarters while shifting out in upper stretch, then wove his way through traffic while making steady progress late. GREAT BAM broke slowly, settled well off the inside in the opening stages, swung eight wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress late. SWIFT PROGRESS settled along the inside early, saved ground on the bend and made an effort to improve position. FEAR NOR FAVOR tracked off the second flight outside foes, was fanned seven wide while between foes racing into upper stretch but had no final bid. PATSY'S PROM DATE broke through the gate

before the start, tracked off the second flight between foes racing into the bend but offered no rally. NO MORE TALKIN, close up five wide in the opening stages, made a brief bid in that path nearing upper stretch but quickly gave way. JACOBS GROUND, urged to secure the lead near the inside from the break, set the pace racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. SIR VALIDATOR tracked the pace four wide between foes in second flight racing to the bend but steadily retreated entering upper stretch. FLYING ACT tracked just off the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight racing into the bend and gave way entering upper stretch.
