Footnotes

SORTA SASSY, reserved in hand stalking the pacesetter along the inside racing to the first turn, shifted out while moving to terms with that foe entering the second bend, took over leaving midstretch and drew away under firm handling. LATIN JOURNEY tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, bid between foes racing into upper stretch and proved best of the others. FRANCES GARDNER, reserved off the second flight along the inside in early stages, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes near the inside and continued willingly between foes to the end while narrowly prevailing for a share. NORTHERN SWALLOW, reserved from striking distance off the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out to split foes five wide racing into upper stretch and was going well late. ISTEFAA broke inwards bumping TARADDUF, was righted to track off the second flight outside foes, moved to challenge four wide nearing upper stretch, was fanned five wide racing through the lane and was just outkicked for a share. SILVER CRUSH hopped at the start, was reserved near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering upper stretch and made an effort to gain some position between foes. ALL HER DUE tracked the leaders in the second flight, moved to challenge three deep between foes nearing upper stretch but flattened out in late stages. EMPIRE LADY moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on her own courage racing into the far turn, couldn't repel the winner's bid and gave way. VARIABLE worked her way to the inside tracking off the second flight in the opening half, continued along the inside to upper stretch but lacked a rally. BELLERIVE settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. TARADDUF broke slowly then was bumped at the start and never seriously menaced. SWEET HARP trailed throughout.
