ROBBING THE BANK settled well, entered the stretch three wide, angled five wide at the furlong marker and rallied. FROSTYBDANCING hugged the rail throughout and stayed on. BEAU JAQUES grabbed the lead, held well into the stretch and was worn down late. WINNER'S STORY chased evenly and offered no response when called upon. NAFIR'S LAD stalked the pace and faded in the stretch. MOVE SAM MOVE passed tiring rivals. STORM BOOT LARRY was outpaced while five wide and never a factor. FRANKIE R. showed brief speed and retreated. WOODYVILLE was always outrun. BY GOLLIE MR OLLIE broke outwardly, was forwardly placed and faltered.
