BAILOUT BUDDY was urged to dispute the pace along the rail in the opening furlong, dueled for command through the bend, edged forward to a narrow advantage near midstretch and gamely held OUR SILVER PEGASUS to the end under pressure. The latter tracked off the first flight outside foes racing through the backstretch, made steady progress four wide on the turn to challenge in that path entering upper stretch, continued with a steady bid to late stages but came up second best. MOST DISTINCT joined the pace five wide in the opening stages, pressed the pace three deep between foes on the turn to midstretch but yielded to the top pair late. FAMILY SIX rated off the first flight along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out three wide in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. PROUD JACKSON tracked off the second flight outside foes, shifted five wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly. BROKEN BOW was a brief factor three wide between foes but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. RUNNINGOUT OF CASH, reserved

in hand while racing widest to the turn, proved no threat. BRIMMERTON never seriously menaced. DOC'S MINE was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset racing into the turn and emptied out after a half. RAILROAD TIE gave way abruptly.
