STAY SOUND raced close up inside, angled out three wide for the drive, rallied to a clear lead and was not menaced while under a mild drive. EL MIRASOL was allowed to settle off the rail, eased out in upper stretch and gained the place in the drive while unable to reach the winner. YANKEE BRASS saved ground, made a bid on the final turn then lacked a winning bid while gaining a share. TEN MILE RANGE lacked speed then gained belatedly in the drive. RAGGED KINGDOM vied for the lead inside but weakened in the run to the wire. DANIELLE'S GRAY, outrun early, advanced in upper stretch but lacked a late bid. PRETORIAN trailed to the stretch and passed tired rivals. THE KAISER was always outrun. REFORMER RALLY raced in good position but tired. EXCITING FANFARE raced close up from the start but gave way. KEENE DANCER contested the pace just outside and tired.
