### Footnotes

LAMBORGENIE, restless in the gate, broke through the barrier before the start, broke readily to gain terms with the first flight along the rail in the opening sixteenth, was eased back to track the leaders under rating saving ground to the far turn, shifted off the inside when presented an opening in upper stretch, was roused to challenge between foes leaving the furlong marker and edged forward late under firm handling. LA PANCHITA, in touch with the leaders three deep between foes in the opening stages, dropped off the first flight to stalk those foes outside the eventual winner racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep leaving the far turn while being urged to advance, struck the front between calls late but couldn't quite contain the winner's final bid. FORTHELONGHAUL was urged to terms on the pace along the inside racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue to gain the advantage on the far turn, dueled for command past midstretch but couldn't quite match terms with the top pair late. A. J.'S LOVE tracked just off the first flight outside foes racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while being roused to challenge but lacked the needed final kick. DUBIOUS worked her way to the inside dropping off the second flight racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, angled out four deep in upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. IT'SALLABOUTRED settled outside a rival off the second flight racing to the backstretch, swung out five wide entering upper stretch but offered no rally. STEELA was urged to force the pace outside foes racing into the first turn, continued to dispute the issue outside a rival on the backstretch, pressed that foe into the far turn and gave way abruptly nearing upper stretch. FRIENDLY SELECTION trailed throughout.
