SOMERS TOUR checked on the first turn, steadied on the backstretch, rallied in the stretch then lacked a winning bid. GRANDE JETE lacked speed and improved her position. SIMPLY SANTA FE pressed the pace just outside and tired. SMOGGY DOGGY raced close up early but weakened. RUSTIC KITTEN made a bid on the final turn but faltered in the drive. SONORA'S MOON was never a factor. FLOR DEL SOL was always outrun. KATIE'S BEST raced close up and gave way. FAIRBERRY LADY was through early.
