SHIP'S CABIN, in touch with the leaders from the outset while rated in hand, stalked the pace three wide on the backstretch, continued in that path entering the far turn while steadily closing the gap, moved to command approaching midstretch then held safe the challenge of VICTORY NOTION under steady handling and some right handed encouragement to the end to prevail. The latter reserved between foes racing out of striking distance in the opening half, swung outside foes on the far turn while being urged to advance, shifted inwards nearing midstretch bumping SON OF TIGER, was collected off that foe to challenge the winner but was always only second best. UNBRIDLED VICAR settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted inwards entering the far turn while commencing his advance, bid between foes entering upper stretch, then shifted out in late stages while continuing in an effort to improve position and earn a share. LITTLE FEAT, urged to secure a forward placing along the inside racing into the first turn, ceded the lead to a rival entering the backstretch to stalk that foe, moved to briefly challenge inside the leader nearing upper stretch but had no final kick. SON OF TIGER shifted off the inside early while being urged to terms with a rival on the pace racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue to gain a clear advantage before a half, dictated the pace on a narrow margin off the inside racing into the far turn, was bumped approaching the furlong marker by VICTORY NOTION and soon gave way. PHOENIX FORCE led the second flight from out of striking distance off the inside racing to the backstretch but offered no closing bid. JOHNNY CADILLAC, reserved saving ground in the opening stages, dropped out to last on the far turn and trailed the field into the stretch.
