### Footnotes

BILL'S PRESENCE, reserved in hand outside a rival in the last flight racing to the far turn, swung out eight wide entering upper stretch and produced a sustained rally to just edge CAT BELLS on the wire under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, held up off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch, shifted out five wide to bid between foes racing into upper stretch, gained the lead between calls late but just failed to contain the winner. THEATRICAL GIRL, firmly rated out of striking distance saving ground in the opening half, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch, angled six wide

racing through the lane and was making steady progress between foes to the end to gain a share. GO FOR THE MOON angled inwards to stalk the pacesetter under rating in the opening half, moved to press the rival between foes racing into upper stretch, edged forward to a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker but couldn't sustain her momentum. HOGAN BEACH worked her way to the rail in early stages tracking off the second flight, shifted out entering upper stretch to split foes three wide, then made an effort to improve her placing in close quarters in late stages while exchanging some contact with FIRST OF FEBRUARY near the sixteenth marker. HEAVENLY LASS was reserved just off the first flight along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out to bid between foes near midstretch but had no final kick. OUR MISS BROOKSIDE, bumped at the start, was reserved off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch, swung out seven wide entering upper stretch but couldn't make a real impression. FIRST OF FEBRUARY, caught four deep in early stages while being prompted to secure a contending position, moved to terms with the first flight entering the far turn to make brief bid nearing upper stretch, gave way leaving the furlong marker and was bumped in late stages. LUCKY GAL, held up three deep as part of the second flight racing to the far turn, continued in that path on the second bend and came up empty entering upper stretch. FORTHELONGHAUL tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the far turn but lacked the needed closing response. COUGAR CRUISE broke outwards bumping OUR MISS BROOKSIDE, was reserved along the inside racing to the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch and was held up when caught in tight quarters racing through the lane. JUST BE THERE, urged to the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, set the pace on narrow margin into the far turn and emptied out nearing midstretch.
