COURTESY CALL gained terms with several rivals on the lead near the inside, attended the pace on her own courage racing into the bend, pressed the issue midway through the turn, then edged away in the closing stages under firm encouragement. SMALL KISS was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the break, pressed the pace outside the eventual winner to upper stretch but proved only second best. ANYONESHOME tracked off the first flight from just out of striking distance racing through the backstretch, angled out five wide in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid to close the gap while earning a share. MIDNIGHT BRUISER settled in last racing to the turn, shifted four wide in upper stretch and made some belated progress. MARVELOUS MATE settled into stride near the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge. GREY LIGHT was urged to dispute the pace three deep between foes racing into the turn and steadily faded after a half. LITTLE JEANNIE ducked outwards at the start, was quickly righted to join the pace four wide, continued to vie for command in that path racing into the turn but gave way abruptly entering upper stretch.
