### Footnotes

THE BEST OPTION, reserved near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch gathering momentum, split foes three deep racing through the stretch while moving to challenge and wrested command in time under firm handling to prevail. HOIST THE COLORS, forwardly placed attending a rival's pace in the opening stages, took over after a half, shifted to the inside dictating the pace, edged clear racing into the stretch but couldn't contain the winner. COURSER was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, relinquished the lead before a half to track just off the leaders into the second bend, shifted out while producing a second effort to challenge between foes in late stages but couldn't quite match the top pair while continuing with interest for a share. MULATA settled in the last flight off the inside racing to the backstretch, angled out six wide in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid in that path. MILESTONEMISSILE ducked out racing into the first turn while gaining a position in the second flight, shifted to the inside on the backstretch, lodged a brief bid inside foes racing into upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. TSUNAMI SALLI, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out racing into the far turn to prompt the pacesetter, couldn't match that foe and gave way leaving the furlong marker. NIKALUK tracked off the second flight outside foes, was fanned five wide racing into the stretch and steadily faded. BASILIO'S THUNDER settled in hand along the inside early and never seriously menaced. PRIMA DONNA PIRATE was steadied a bit off the second flight racing into the first turn, shifted out racing to the backstretch tracking the pace outside foes but steadily faded in the drive.
