Footnotes

LEMONDROSPRITZER secured a forward placing from the outset prompting a rival's pace racing into the turn, edged forward to a narrow advantage after a half and maintained a narrow margin to the end under firm left handed pressure. TOAST WITH HONEY, off a step behind the leaders, tracked the pace off the second flight along the rail, came through close quarters nearing the turn to advance inside foes, swung out five wide in upper stretch and found her best stride in the closing stages to narrowly prevail for place honors while moving to gain terms with the winner. REBA'S FANCY tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing into the bend, shifted three wide, then four wide racing into upper stretch while moving to challenge and continued willingly between foes in that path to the end while just missing for second. AUTUMN SPLENDOR, urged along inside rivals as part of the second flight tracking the leaders, shifted out in upper stretch to bid between foes inside the pacesetter but was outkicked in the final stages. CASHA was urged to the lead along the rail in the opening stages, dueled for command through the turn and gave way in upper stretch when failing to match the winner. TECNICA, bumped at the start, settled in the last flight between foes early, was steadied a bit while advancing three deep between foes entering the turn, continued six wide into upper stretch to gain some position but proved no real threat. SILVER DIRECTION settled in last outside foes, raced five wide into the turn and never seriously menaced. SLIGO ROSE tracked the leaders four wide, then five wide racing into the turn and never gained contention. OLIVIA LOU was a brief factor between foes in the second flight but dropped out early.
