STRAITFROMMYHEART raced close up while well off the rail, took the lead on the turn and drew off while kept to her task. ACCEPT DOMRA lacked speed while five wide and rallied for the place while no danger to the winner. PEYTONS PLEASURE raced four wide and rallied belatedly for a share. STARSHIP GARNET had early speed inside and weakened. WHOSTHEBETTERHALF pressed the pace from just outside and weakened. SHARI LEE failed to reach contention. GRITTY KITTY was bumped at the start, raced close up and weakened. MARCH HARE saved ground but tired. MONEY STRETCHER was never a factor. DAYLIGHT ROBBERY was bumped at the start and was always outrun. JAGUAR LORD was also outrun. TINY COMET was never close.
