BREATHTAKINGBREEZE got off a step slow then moved up along the inside and was gaining to be second best. LUCKY LIZA broke sharply and battled for a half then gave way in the stretch. WINK AT RICHIE was allowed to settle, made a rail rally on the turn and a steady advance in the stretch. HIWAY SIXTY WEST raced close up and chased to the turn then tired. NAVY FLEET raced in the second flight between horses, dropped back into the turn then made no rally. COSMO BABE chased the pace, steadied on the backstretch then came up empty late. MAXY LEVENS raced close up with a wide trip, moved five wide on the turn then flattened out.
