Footnotes

UNPAID CRUSADE, held up just off the leaders along the inside racing into the backstretch, continued under some reserve while making steady progress to gain terms with the pacesetter on the far turn, switched outside that foe nearing midstretch, then wrested command and held safe the challenge of TIDY UP under firm handling. The latter tracked the pace between foes in second flight into the far turn, came through along the inside to challenge nearing midstretch but proved only second best. TWO NINETY FIVE, reserved saving ground in the opening stages, made steady progress inside foes racing into the far turn to gain contention then continued willingly inside foes racing into the stretch to gain a share late. SAM OWEN, forwardly placed along the inside

in the opening stages, dueled for command nearing the far turn, edged away to a clear advantage after six furlongs, gave way once headed by the winner and drifted out markedly in the closing stages. NIC THE QUICK, reserved near the inside from out of striking distance early, shifted out entering the far turn to split foes three wide making steady progress into upper stretch but lacked the necessary final response. DURAZNO, reserved outside a rival tracking well off the second flight into the backstretch, was caught four wide between foes racing through the far turn but had no final bid. IS HE PROUD, reserved outside foes three or four deep racing to the backstretch, passed tiring rivals late. COPPER FOREST tracked off the second flight three deep into the far turn and steadily faded. OPTIMER (ARG), off a step slowly, tracked the pace unhurried between foes in the last flight early and never gained striking distance. AMBER'S SHORTY tracked off the second flight outside a rival into the backstretch but steadily retreated after a half. BRUNZER joined the pace three deep racing into the backstretch, couldn't match the leaders after five furlongs and steadily faded from contention. STARSHIP SUPREME urged to join the pace between foes racing into the backstretch, dueled outside a rival into the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch.
