Footnotes

DOILOOKFATNTHESE moved to the fore inside foes in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend, forged clear nearing upper stretch and widened her advantage under hand urging. INDY BOUQUET, brushed at the start, was reserved along the inside tracking off the second flight to the far turn, came inside foes to gain some position nearing upper stretch, shifted off nearing the furlong marker and secured the place. DE DANANN settled along the rail in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and improved her position to the end. WYN JYM tracked just off the pacesetter under light rating racing to the backstretch, couldn't match the leader after six furlongs and faded in upper stretch. WINNING STAR swerved off the inside early momentarily impeding TALKING AND SINGING, was righted to track between foes just off the second flight, continued between foes while angling out in upper stretch but had no final bid. TALKIN AND SINGING, forced a bit wide racing into the first turn tracking just off the leaders, recovered to make a brief, three wide advance on the far turn but lacked the needed final response. SILVER CRUSH tracked the pace between foes off the second flight into the far turn and continued evenly to late stages. YOU'RE TOO WILD settled off the inside in the opening half and never gained contention. STORMY TESS, a bit rank under restraint tracking just inside the leaders, came up empty when called upon to advance racing through the far turn. SEE NO STARS, caught wide to the backstretch, never gained contention. ZIPPING AWAY was caught five deep racing into the first turn, continued very wide to the backstretch and dropped out on the far turn. JALAL, held up just off the first flight into the backstretch, made a brief bid on the far turn but emptied out

abruptly after six furlongs.
