Footnotes

CIToyEN STYLE broke sharply, set the pace racing well off the inside in the opening stages, forged clear midway through the turn, drifted out racing into upper stretch and extended his advantage to the end while shifting out markedly in the last furlong. MILKY MAY, bumped at the start, was urged to press the pacesetter racing along the rail into the bend, couldn't match that foe after a half but proved best of the others. TERRIFIC TIM, reserved outside foes in the opening stages, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and made some progress to improve his position. ABACO STORM swerving in and out racing in the last flight in early stages, angled to the inside nearing the turn, shifted out to split foes in upper stretch, then came through tight quarters leaving the furlong marker to improve his placing. BLACKHAWK RED, carried out a bit in traffic in the opening furlong, tracked the leader outside rivals in the second flight racing into the turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. CHAMBER OF BULLETS broke outwards bumping MILKY MAY, was settled off the inside racing to the turn but never seriously menaced. STAR RATING, urged to position inside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, steadily retreated in upper stretch. CASA SACA dropped out of contention early.
