### Footnotes

TIGER MIKE urged to secure a forward placing three deep racing to the first turn, tracked the leaders in that path under light rating racing to the far turn, moved to challenge when given his cue midway through the second bend, forged clear into upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. CHAMPION KID broke sharply, prompted the pace outside a rival racing to the far turn, couldn't match terms with the winner's bid racing into upper stretch but proved best of the others. PEYTONVILLE, held up out of tight quarters early, settled near the inside racing to the far turn, swung out nearing upper stretch and continued well enough to prevail for a share. E. BLUE, reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch, briefly advanced to contention inside foes on the far turn but had no closing bid. HIGH FLYING JAKE tracked the leaders off the inside from out of striking distance into the backstretch, made steady progress three deep to gain contention entering the far turn but emptied out leaving midstretch. NOLANGRANT'SKITTEN, unhurried outside foes tracking off the second flight, was fanned five wide racing into the stretch but made no impact. HUNGRY WILDCAT, reserved along the inside just off the second flight early, never mounted a serious challenge. PEACE NOW, urged to the lead along the rail racing into the backstretch, gave way after a half.
