Footnotes

TAYLER'S DESTINY, urged to terms with several rivals on the pace from the break, relinquished the lead to a rival after the opening furlong to stalk that foe racing to the turn, shifted out entering the bend while readily closing the gap on the leader, took over entering upper stretch and drove clear. LITTLE FRANCES tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight early, made a steady, three wide bid racing into upper stretch and prevailed for place honors while no menace to the winner. SCREEN SIREN tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, continued with a steady bid to challenge nearing midstretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was outfinished for second. HAPPY CAPER was hustled to the lead three deep between foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail once clear, dueled inside a rival for command on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. SWIFT MELVA settled between foes out of striking distance early, angled out racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. GOOD AND EVIL tracked the leaders along the inside off the second flight in early stages and continued evenly into the stretch. TACTICS RAP, urged along pursuing the pacesetter racing nearest the rail in the opening quarter, steadily faded racing into upper stretch. HOLY CLASSIC settled into stride off the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge. TACTICAL KATIE was a brief factor four wide between foes in the second flight but steadily retreated from contention on the turn. ILLINOIS ROSE trailed throughout.
