Footnotes

DEVIL IN DISGUISE took up a position racing just off the first flight under reserve racing to the backstretch, continued between rivals in the second flight racing to the far turn, was prompted to advance and challenge inside the pacesetter racing into upper stretch, wrested a narrow advantage nearing the furlong marker and steadily edged clear under firm left handed prompting. NACHAS AND JOY secured terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn attending the tempo, pressed the issue three deep entering the second bend to gain a clear advantage after six furlongs, resisted when challenged by the winner racing through upper stretch but proved only second best while ducking a bit in late stages. HERE COMES MARIO settled off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, gathered some momentum while shifting out four wide racing into upper stretch and edged a rival for a share on the wire. REAL POWER, pulling a bit in early stages while angling to the inside gaining a position in the second flight, shifted out on the far turn to challenge four deep racing into upper stretch but lost his momentum when lugging inwards, then was outfinished for third. PERDIDO PASS raced four wide tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was roused to advance nearing upper stretch but made no impression while swerving between foes racing through the lane. DEFIANT FLYER, caught wide racing to the backstretch, came around foes on the far turn to make a brief, five wide bid nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. MY SAMURAI, held up out of tight quarters near the inside just after the start, came through inside foes after a half to make brief bid along the rail entering the far turn but emptied out quickly entering upper stretch. KID CHIC, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the break racing to the backstretch, emptied out abruptly midway through the far turn. ROMO TIME was steadied between foes in close quarters racing through the first turn turn, shifted to the inside gaining a position just off the second flight on the backstretch but dropped out quickly on the far turn. COPPER MONKEY

was scratched after suffering an injury leaving the paddock, necessitating a consolation daily double.
