Footnotes

NAUGHTY AND NICE angled inwards to track just off the first flight outside a rival under light rating racing into the turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command and kick clear late under firm handling. JUDY MY DARLING moved to the fore from the break, dictated the pace racing off the rail racing into the bend, maintained the advantage past midstretch, couldn't fend off the winner's bid but continued willingly to prevail for place honors. WHYPRINCESSWHY, forwardly placed attending a rival's pace in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes racing into upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. OUR GIRL MAGIC settled into stride along the inside from out of striking distance early, saved ground to upper stretch then came around a tiring foe to make some belated progress along the rail. MICHALINA, held up when caught in some tight quarters at the start, settled outside a rival racing to the turn, shifted out in upper stretch to gain some position late but made no real impression. GLORIOUS DESTINY, in close attendance to the pace four wide racing to the turn, steadily faded nearing upper stretch while drifting out. DOROTHY Y angled inwards to track off the first flight racing into the bend, was urged to lodge a brief bid inside the leaders but quickly emptied out.
