Footnotes

TWO MONTHS RENT was settled off the second flight while angling to the inside racing to the backstretch, made steady progress along the inside to gain contention nearing upper stretch, shifted off the rail in late stages to split foes while being roused to challenge the leader and just edged that foe on the wire under strong handling. FILM SHOT, within striking distance in the opening stages, tracked just off the first flight near the inside racing to the far turn, was urged to challenge nearest the rail racing into upper stretch, gained the advantage late but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. LEA, caught four wide racing to the first turn tracking well out of striking distance in the opening half, angled to the inside on the far turn and continued to make steady progress along the rail to late stages to gain position while prevailing for a share. CONTROL TOWER settled three deep between foes in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch while being roused to advance and made some mild progress late. NORTH OF NEVER settled while working his way to the inside racing to the first turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance, then continued with a mild bid five deep between foes. FINALE moved to the lead soon after the break while shifting off the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside racing to the far turn, was roused to maintain the advantage to midstretch but failed to sustain his momentum. FRANCOIS angled to the inside early gaining a position just off the second flight, shifted out four wide leaving the midway point of the far turn while being prompted to advance but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. ALDOUS SNOW settled in last racing to the far turn and never seriously menaced. QUICK WIT was settled between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing the far turn while being prompted to gain some position but had no closing bid. ALL STORMY, prominent between foes in the opening stages, prompted the pacesetter in the three path racing to the far turn and emptied out nearing midstretch. PLEASANT CLOSING was a brief

factor racing within striking distance racing five wide to the backstretch but dropped out after a half. ALL SQUARED AWAY was a brief factor four wide between foes stalking the leaders in the opening half but dropped out abruptly entering the far turn.
