Footnotes

CHURUBUSCO forwardly placed from the outset, angled three wide into the stretch and rallied under a drive. DIAMOND STEAL reserved early, entered the stretch three wide and finished well. ROCK RIDGE ROAD had his shoe fixed in the paddock, was outrun early, swung six wide into the stretch and made a late bid. THE ELEVATOR raced evenly. LIGHTHOUSE JUDGE grabbed the lead, was headed leaving the turn and gave way. J. PA never menaced. OUT FOR A SPIN stalked the pace and weakened. COCKADOODLE outpaced early, was urged on the turn and offered no response. MADDY'S BOBCAT showed little interest.
