**Footnotes**

CITY NUMBER was settled out of striking distance off the inside early, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command in the final stages under firm handling. MILITARY LEGEND, reserved from striking distance while angling to the rail in the opening stages, gradually gained contention while angling out racing through the stretch, shifted into the six path leaving the furlong marker and prevailed for second. MY MAN JAY tracked just off the leaders racing four wide in the second flight, moved to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch, contested the issue past the furlong marker but was outfinished by the top pair. GATO'S PIRATE tracked just off the leaders between foes three wide in the second flight, bid between foes in that path nearing upper stretch, exchanged some contact with OFFICER FRANK nearing midstretch while contesting the lead but gave way late. OFFICER FRANK secured terms with a rival to attend that foe's pace in the opening stages, pressed the pace racing into the bend, gained a narrow advantage after a half, dueled between foes into upper stretch, exchanged some contact near the furlong marker and soon gave way. ROCKERFELLER was urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the turn, weakened entering upper stretch, then finished in hand in the last furlong when caught in some close quarters late. HE'S HOT SAUCE trailed throughout.
