Footnotes

INDANAMEOFDAFATHER, bumped at the start, shifted off the inside gaining a position just off the leaders under rating racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady, three wide bid on the far turn to gain terms with the pacesetter in upper stretch, continued in an extended skirmish with that foe for command past the furlong marker and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. HERO OF ORDER bobbled at the start, quickly recovered then was urged to secure the lead along the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the far turn, dueled for command into upper stretch and grudgingly resisted the winner to the end. BUDDYBDANCING, reserved off foes while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch, tracked the leaders between foes from just out of striking distance, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages while prevailing for a share. PACKLEN'S BID angled inwards to gain a forward placing racing to the backstretch, stalked the pacesetter to the second bend, moved to press between foes racing into upper stretch but weakened nearing the furlong marker. BLUEGRASS TYPE angled to the rail early while being held up just off the first flight, tracked the leaders along the inside to the far turn but lacked the needed closing bid. BRIARTOWN broke inwards bumping the eventual winner, was reserved outside foes racing to the backstretch, continued four wide through the backstretch and steadily faded entering the far turn.
