### Footnotes

FOREST RUN, urged to terms with several rivals on the pace racing three deep between foes in the first turn, was held up just off the leaders stalking those foes racing through the backstretch, readily moved to wrest command when given his cue midway through the far turn, forged clear to a commanding advantage near midstretch and held sway to the end under steady prompting. SAILING ALONG, bumped soundly at the start, was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes gathering momentum on the far turn, swung six wide racing into upper stretch and made steady late progress to prevail for place honors. IKAROS broke awkwardly bumping LO ME at the start, was settled into stride outside foes racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady bid while shifting out five wide racing into upper stretch and was just outfinished for second in the closing stages. HE'S SULTRY, reserved off the second flight between foes in the opening half, angled out seven wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve his placing. BIG POPPA D

trailed the field to the stretch, then shifted out eight wide approaching the furlong marker to make some belated progress. CAST A COLD EYE, a bit rank early while being prompted to join the pace four wide racing into the first turn, tracked just off the first flight in that path racing into the second bend but lacked the needed closing response. LARKFLITE, caught in tight quarters between foes prompting the pace racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue into the second bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. PLAYON PLAYER broke outwards bumping SAILING ALONG, was quickly righted, then urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing to the backstretch, forced the issue into the second bend and gave way entering upper stretch. LO ME broke awkwardly, then was bumped just after the start, recovered to gain a position outside foes tracking off the second flight, continued four, then five wide between foes racing through the far turn to upper stretch and had no closing response. CELTIC EXPRESS, reserved along the inside from just out of striking distance early, never gained contention. REGGIVILLE tracked the pace between foes off the second flight in the opening half and steadily retreated from contention. A NICE SLEWISH BOY tracked just off the first flight while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch but steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
