Footnotes

AIKMAN was prompted to gain terms with the first flight three deep in the opening stages attending the pace, was urged to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch, drifted inwards under pressure leaving the furlong marker while gaining a narrow advantage to make some contact with GRUDGE MATCH, then shifted in twice more bumping that foe in the last furlong while narrowly prevailing in a prolonged drive. The latter broke sharply, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside racing to the turn, dueled for command along the inside into upper stretch and was just outfinished despite resisting the winner's bid to the end while being bumped repeatedly in late stages. TRIPLE OVERTIME shifted a bit off the inside early leading the second flight into the bend from just out of striking distance, shifted outside the leaders racing through the stretch while making steady progress to the end to gain a share. GAVILAN bobbled at the start, was settled into stride, swung out five wide nearing upper stretch and continued with an effort to improve position. CHAPTER TWELVE worked his way to the inside early tracking off the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly inside foes. YES SIR OFFICER tracked off the second flight unhurried in the opening stages, was urged to advance between foes racing through the turn but had no closing bid. COWBOY JONES, a bit slow into stride, settled outside foes, raced eight wide into upper stretch and never seriously menaced. MIKE'S GUST O was rated in hand three deep in second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. DISTINCT ADVANTAGE, off a step behind the leaders, was urged to gain terms with the pacesetter in the opening furlong, forced the issue between foes into the bend and gave way in upper stretch. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF GRUDGE MATCH LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF AIKMAN. THE STEWARDS REVIEWED THE STRETCH RUN AND DISQUALIFIED AIKMAN FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM SECOND.
