Footnotes

SUSPENDED MOON sprinted to the lead while angling to the inside, set the pace on a clear margin into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. AUTUMN GLORY broke sharply, tracked just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, couldn't close the gap on that foe racing through the stretch but prevailed for the place. PLAY US OUT hopped at the start, angled immediately to the inside, gathered momentum racing through the far turn, swung four wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to just miss second. NO RETREAT, reserved off the second flight outside foes in the opening half, angled to the rail entering the far turn and continued willingly inside foes racing through the stretch to close the gap. GORGEMOUS tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, angled three wide commencing a steady advance leaving the far turn but was outkicked in the drive. THUNDERING BROOK tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside to the far turn, made some progress in tandem with a rival on the second bend but lacked the needed closing bid. PINCH OF JOY angled inwards gaining a forward placing, led the second flight racing to the far turn, couldn't menace the top flight after six furlongs and emptied out in the drive. LOVE MONEY was settled off the inside in the opening stages and offered no rally.

GRAY SILK, reserved off the inside in the opening half, offered no rally. MIKEY'S REDHEAD broke in the air, settled between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch but never gained contention. ANCIENT EYES was a brief factor outside foes in the second flight but dropped out after a half. JUBILANT JENNY drifted very wide racing into the first turn while under pressure to contend, made brief progress four deep racing into the backstretch but gave way abruptly after a half.
