Footnotes

CATFEINATED ducked outwards at the start, was quickly righted to gain terms with a rival on the lead along the inside, attended that foe's pace under some reserve racing into the bend, went clear nearing upper stretch, then was roused to extend his advantage to the end under right handed prompting. MR. ALANZO was held up off the second flight in the opening stages, made his way nearer to the inside entering the turn, gathered some momentum while shifting out four wide in upper stretch and continued well enough to secure the place in the final strides. GREELEY'S FORTUNE, forwardly placed outside foes in the opening stages, tracked just off the first flight three deep under rating, advanced to challenge three deep after a half, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was outfinished for the place. WINDY CITY LEAL, reserved well off the inside early, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. NIMO was hustled to the front from between foes, dueed outside the eventual winner racing into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. BIG BAD MIKE tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening quarter, angled four wide entering the turn and steadily faded after a half. CONIR was guided to the rail in the opening stages to track the leaders in second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and steadily retreated in the drive. GOLD DE LAC broke awkwardly, lost position to the field and never seriously menaced. POOF AND GONE was a brief factor between foes in the second flight but dropped out nearing upper stretch. MUST BE LUCKY tracked the pace three deep between foes off the second flight racing to the turn but dropped out of contention early.
