RELAXING GREEN lacked speed, angled out and rallied to contention but flattened out. ECHO SPRING set the pace, took a clear lead on the final turn. WHAT A SPLASH never reached a contending position. EDEN PARK raced close up inside and tired. ILLINI QUEEN was never a factor. EISHIN ILLINI NOW lacked speed and showed little. ELISHA JOY raced close up and gave way. REFAX raced near the middle of the field and gave way. TOO CLEVER raced close up inside and tired.
