DOT'S IN STYLE sprinted clear, held well into the stretch and maintained her healthy advantage to the wire. PUNTA BALLENA saved ground, remained inside for the stretch run and finished well. TAKING STOCK stalked the pace and stayed on without threatening. ROBIN MY GIRL reserved early, entered the stretch three wide and managed no rally. GILDED TREASURE raced in striking position while five wide, remained five wide into the stretch and had no finishing punch. SEASIDE HOME raced forwardly along the inside and faded. ADDED DELIGHT was outpaced while four wide and offered no response when asked. NEED FOR PATIENCE failed to menace. JADE'S QUEST outrun early, was eased on the turn and vanned off.
