Footnotes

BURGAN RULES broke sharply, dictated the pace along inside racing into the backstretch, edged away to a clear advantage near midstretch and just held the challenge of CALDO CAT under firm handling. The latter, reserved near the inside in the opening half, split foes in upper stretch and produced his best stride late to just miss. LEROY'S PRIDE joined a foe on the pace while attending the tempo under some reserve in the opening stages, pressed the issue into upper stretch but weakened when failing to match the winner. FAN TAN MAN tracked outside foes in the second flight, advanced three deep to challenge nearing upper stretch but flattened out. SMOKY STORM tracked the pace unhurried along the inside from out of striking distance early, shifted four wide in upper stretch and made some mild progress. CHOCTAW SMOKE tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch, angled four wide entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. PROUD NATION tracked the leaders three wide in the second flight to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing response. SPARSE settled along the inside early but never gained contention. TIMES UP, caught four wide racing into the first turn, soon dropped out of contention. DYNAMAGIC broke out, bumped CHOCTAW SMOKE, raced three deep between foes to the backstretch and never seriously menaced. LET'S POP THE CORK tracked just off the leaders along the rail racing to the backstretch, gave way abruptly nearing the far turn, was soon outdistanced, then was collected by the outrider near the finish line and walked off the course after it was determined an ambulance was not

required.
