GO POSSE GO tracked the pace unhurried off the second flight in the opening stages, made steady progress advancing to striking position racing four wide through the turn, moved to wrest command in that path entering upper stretch and drew away under firm encouragement. CARSON'S VENTURE was urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace on a clear margin racing into the turn, proved no match when confronted by the winner but just lasted to finish on even terms with a rival for place honors. ATS GOOD tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight racing to the turn, moved to challenge between foes nearing upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but finished on even terms with a rival for place honors. DON CARMELO tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight, made a brief bid midway through the turn but steadily weakened in the drive. UNSPOKEN DESIRE settled along the inside early, shifted out to split foes in upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. WELL SHOOT tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight racing to the bend but steadily faded after a half. JINGLE JANGLE settled outside a rival early, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression.
