**Footnotes**

LOST FORTY tracked just off the pacesetter racing three wide into the backstretch, made a steady advance in that path to challenge in upper stretch, wrested command and edged away under firm handling. GARBURETOR, reserved in last racing to the backstretch, swung five wide nearing the midway point of the far turn while commencing his challenge, continued outside foes into upper stretch and prevailed for second. GRATTAN STREET, held up between foes tracking off the second flight in the opening half, made steady progress to split foes near midstretch gaining striking distance and was unfinished for second. TOO MANY SINS, carried a out bit by WHERE'S WINSTON racing into the first turn while moving to a position in the second flight, moved to press the pace between foes racing through the far turn but faded in late stages. FULL FLAME held up along the inside racing into the first turn, shifted outside foes on the backstretch, made a brief, four wide bid nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. SARKOZY tracked the pace unhurried outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained striking distance. CROOK'S BODGIT, urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace into the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. WHERE'S WINSTON, urged to contention along the rail while getting out a bit in early stages, tracked the leaders along the inside racing to the far turn and steadily faded.
