Footnotes

JOST VAN DYKE settled into stride a bit off the inside while under racing in last into the bend, shifted out to advance five deep between foes racing into upper stretch and continued with a sustained response to just edge OH MY TODD in the final strides under strong handling. The latter, held up off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch while steadily gaining position, switched out to bid between foes just off the inside leaving the furlong marker, struck the front between calls nearing the wire but was just collared by the winner. UPSELL, steadied a bit avoiding close quarters just after the start, was reserved in the last flight while shifting off the inside racing into the bend, angled seven wide in upper stretch while being prompted to advance and continued with a solid late response to close the gap while being just outkicked by the top pair. HEART DOCTOR tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes four deep advancing between rivals and continued willingly to the end. STIG'S DEPUTY tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight four deep in the opening quarter, continued in that path nearing upper stretch while making steady progress to challenge for command, gained the advantage in upper stretch but failed to sustain that momentum. LATENT RUSH was urged to dispute the pace while angling to the rail racing into the bend, dueled into upper stretch and gave way in late stages. ALL TANKED UP

tracked the pace between foes in the second flight early, was shuffled back avoiding close quarters racing into the bend, continued with interest to lodge a brief bid four wide in the lane but lacked the needed final kick. PETERS ROCK tracked the leaders three deep between foes in second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. UNO PECADOR was urged to dispute the pace between foes racing into the bend but gave way early. LUCK WITH A KISS, caught five wide early, was urged to press the issue three deep racing into the bend, drifted out nearing upper stretch and abruptly gave way.
