Footnotes

PREOCCUPIED was rated saving ground racing just out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted off the inside gaining some position between foes on the far turn, was switched out four deep in upper stretch while being roused between foes to challenge, wrested a narrow advantage nearing the sixteenth marker and edged forward under stout pressure. DOCTOR TROTTER, reserved out of tight quarters at the start, continued under light reserve saving ground to the second bend, swung eight wide racing into upper stretch while being roused to advance and was making solid progress late while narrowly prevailing for the place honors. BRIM worked his way to the inside early tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, came through close quarters just off the rail to split foes in late stages and was just outkicked for second. EL TRUENOS angled to the inside to stalk just off the first flight under rating, continued along the rail through the far turn to upper stretch, was urged to challenge inside foes racing through the stretch but finished evenly in late stages. DALAXY tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, commenced a steady, four wide advance on the far turn, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch while gaining striking distance but failed to sustain his momentum. JOHAR

IRISH joined the pace outside a rival racing to the first turn, prompted that foe racing to the far turn, pressed between foes into upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. JOHN GALT was urged to dispute the pace a bit off the rail racing to the backstretch, dueled for command to midstretch and gave out late. WICKLOW settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, angled inwards on the far turn to split foes three deep racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. COOL PREN tracked the leaders, four wide, then three wide in second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded between foes racing into the stretch. KID CHIC tracked the pace between in the second flight, shifted out nearing the far turn to lodge a brief four wide bid but quickly dropped out entering upper stretch.
