BREEZY POINT, brushed at the start, took up a position tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance while shifting well off the rail racing to the turn, was guided to the five path in upper stretch and produced a stout rally in the closing stages to wrest command in time under brisk handling. MISH MOSH broke sharply, dictated the pace on a narrow margin between foes remaining well off the inside racing into the turn, edged clear of his foes nearing midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner late. ROSSCAT tracked just off the first flight outside foes in the opening stages, was urged to challenge four wide racing into upper stretch and finished evenly late while earning a share. MR. FLEXIBLE, in close attendance to the pace three deep in the opening stages, was urged to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. TURN N' FIRE broke outwards brushing the eventual winner, was settled into stride along the inside racing into the turn, shifted out entering upper stretch to gain some position but never gained striking distance. ACROSS TIME, forwardly placed along the inside prompting a rival's pace, saved ground on the turn and steadily faded after a half. LALO'S BABY BEAR was settled between foes in the last flight racing to the turn and never gained striking distance. SKY BLUE MONGOLIA settled outside foes in the last flight early and never mounted a serious challenge.
