PA got squeezed back at the start, showed no speed then made a belated bid while six wide. LAMBADA raced in the second flight, made a four wide bid on the turn but faltered. BROTHER G. was void of speed, moved up along the inside then gave way in the stretch. E HARNER chased the pace, was asked between then faded. MALABAR BLUES showed no speed and was no factor.
