Footnotes

TENS WILD, unhurried tracking the leaders from out of striking distance a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, pulled his way to contention between foes after a half, continued under patient handling awaiting an opening on the far turn, shifted to the rail nearing upper stretch while being roused to challenge, struck the front inside foes near midstretch and edged clear late under firm right handed encouragement. SAHM LIKE IT HOT, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages, was rated just off the leaders for a half, commenced a steady bid in that path entering the far turn, struck the front between calls nearing upper stretch, disputed the issue past midstretch, couldn't match the winner late but proved best of the others. CHAS THE MAN, in touch with the pacesetter from the outset while attending that foe's pace, pressed the issue between foes entering the far turn to gain the advantage after six furlongs, couldn't match the top pair nearing midstretch and steadily weakened late. WILDWOOD PERFECT tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight in the opening half, was shuffled a bit midway through the far turn when caught behind a tiring foe, came around that rival nearing upper stretch to challenge along the rail and continued with a mild bid inside foes to late stages while just missing for a share. REGGVILLE settled in last racing to the far turn and passed only tiring rivals. THERE'S NO TELLING tracked just off the first flight in the opening stages, shifted out four deep nearing the backstretch while dropping back from that position, continued four wide into the second bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. SPECIALIST was urged to secure the lead while angling inside, set the pace on a narrow margin racing to the far turn and emptied out midway through the second bend.
