MY DALLAS stalked the pace from off the rail and weakened. VALID MISS DRESS raced close up early but tired. CHASTITY made a mild bid on the turn but faltered. ALWAYS COOL tired. B. J.'S POWERHOUSE set the pace on a clear lead and tired. DOWAGER LADY was always outrun. CORONA HILLS was never close.
